

Guide to sending manuscripts to the editors of Galactica Media: Journal of Media Studies

1. To submit your manuscript to the editorial office of the online journal, please click on the **<u>SUBMISSIONS</u>**, after logging in with your username and password. You will see the following page:

Submission Preparation Checklist Edit

As part of the submission process, authors are required to check off their submission's compliance with all of the following items, and submissions may be returned to authors that do not adhere to these guidelines.

- The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided in Comments to the Editor).
- The author(s) consents to the use of his name and email and agrees with Licence
- The submission files are in Microsoft Word ((DOCX or DOC)), or RTF document file format.
- Where available, URLs for the references have been provided.
- The text is single-spaced; uses a 14-point font; employs italics, rather than underlining (except with URL addresses); and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.
- The text follows the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in our e-journal's Author Guidelines.
- References contains at least 25 sources
- 2. This page contains:

a) Submission Preparation Checklist;

b) Author Guidelines and documents to be submitted with templates information about authors and manuscripts;

- c) Editorial Review Procedures;
- d) Copyright Notice;
- e) Privacy Statement.

3. Please read all of these materials before submitting. This will help avoid unnecessary problems.

4. So, you have completed the original study and you want to send it to the editorial office of our online journal for consideration and possible publication. Before sending, you must prepare the material in accordance with the requirements of the online publication.

5. First of all, the text of the finished article must be divided into two files:

a) information about the author(s);

b) the text of the article proper with a heading, annotation, keywords and a list of references.

6. To do this, download two templates in one of the three formats presented:

1. Author's biographical information- in docx, rtf or odt document which contains in English the author/s' full name, position, place of work, work address and personal e-mail; Please download one of the templates:

2. Text of the article (without Information about the author)in docx, rtf or odt document (Please download one of the templates:

7. Fill in the templates by following the instructions and recommendations written inside. For convenient text formatting, use ready-made styles inside templates

8. Requirements for the article you will find on the same page below:

a) Article title – font Times New Roman, size-14. The title of the paper should fully reflect the problem presented in the article.

b) Article abstract from 150 to 250 words maximum; font Times New Roman, size-12;

c) Internet Searchable Keywords- up to a maximum of 10;

d) Article text in full formatted as follows: equal width; paragraph-1.5 cm; font-Times New Roman; font size-14. The text of the article should be divided into semantic parts:IMRAD (Introduction, methods, results, and discussion)

e) References in the text within round brackets to include the surname, year of publication and the page of the quotation (Smith, 2009, p. 250);

f) If the name of the scientist quoted by the author is found in the text, there is no need to reiterate it in brackets (2009, p. 250). Or: Johnson (2005) wrote...

g) References must be organized according to APA standards, which are available for perusal on the APA Website: https://www.apastyle.org/learn/quick-guide-on-references#In-Text Or: https://www.mendeley.com/guides/apa-citation-guide 9. Having completed the materials in accordance with the requirements, please proceed to the accompanying documents.

10. After preparing the materials, we will proceed to directly sending the manuscript to the editors of the online journal. To do this, click on the "<u>Make a new submission</u>" button

13. To get started, select the language of the material. If the text of the article is written in Russian, select the language of the material Russian; if in English - English.

14. Select the section of the journal that you think your manuscript corresponds to.

15. Check the box next to all subsequent items of the requirements for the material to be sent. Check if your article meets the stated requirements of the journal
